Low-tech single message voice output device: Paraeducator will have peer help record message prior to circle time. Whencued by teacher, student will activate voice output devices to respond. Calendar and story time activities will be supplemented with additional picture	Teach paraeducator to program voice output device. Teach Sophia how to activate the voice output device to respond to teacher's requests during story and calendar time. Teacher will collect data on Sofia's response using the voice output device. Follow-Up Plan Team will meet to discuss progress
