Website	Description
11 Free Reading Websites for Kids	A reasonable number of sites to review. (Some are duplicates of sites listed in this table)
Accessible Book Collection	The Accessible Book Collection is a non-profit corporation, whose primary mission is to provide high interest/low reading level digital text to qualified persons with disabilities. Government and non-profit schools and others can subscribe to Accessible Book Collection. A large selection of e-books is available for all their eligible students.
BookFlix Online	Scholastic pairing of videos with non-fiction text to build understanding (PreK-3). Free trial available.
CAST UDL Book Builder	Over 500 books published by various authors, some with TTS.
CAST UDL Editions	Digital books that use interactive media, leveled supports and more. For ages 10 and up.
Ck-12	Free content based (STEM) ebooks in multi-modal formats & supports. Includes assessments. Content can be presented at different levels for learners
Get Epic	Free for Educators, Read to Me books, thousands of ebooks up to age 12.
ICDL (International Children's Digital Library)	Interesting collection of books from all cultures (but can be viewed/read in English). Some are quite old. Use iSpeech for TTS on computer for some books- others are images of pages & not TTS compatible.
Learning Page	Download free printable nonfiction books
Magic Keys Books	Books categorized for young children, older children, young adults. Speaker icon indicates audio
Merlot	Merlot is a curated collection of free and open online teaching, learning, and faculty development services contributed and used by an international education community (more than ebooks).
National Geographic Explorer	Beautiful nonfiction books for all ages with TTS
Online Children's Books	This webmix contains links to free online picture books. They are for children of all ages as well.

RAZ-Kids	From Reading A-Z for students K-5th grade. Subscription based, but free samples are available.
Starfall	Stories appropriate for Early Childhood through second grade. Stories are categorized according to early emergent readers through advanced emergent readers. Human narration- sentences highlighted
Storyline Online	Books are read by actors in a “story-time presentation”
Story Share	Story Share provides high quality content for students who read below grade level beyond elementary school.
Tumble Books	Subscriptions for different collections: Tumblebook Library, TumblebookCloud, TumblebookCloud Jr, AudiobookCloud for early readers- middle/high school. Provide highlighted text and optional audio narration.
Unite For Literacy	Free audio books (human reader, not TTS). Non-fiction, for early readers. Some appropriate for older students.

We Give Books	Free online picture books/early readers without audio or TTS capabilities
